#### **Evolutionary approach**

- Humans emerged from lower animals
- We still have strong instincts
- Frans de Waal: in some primates exist primitive mechanisms of morality
- Perspective taking empathy
- Consolation compassion



- Social construct is the claim of feminists that there is no difference between sexes
- Differences are not sharp
- Unmanly men and masculine women
- We can consider differences with some reservations



#### Care is task of women

- Care for children and for household
- In medicine cure / care
- Emphasis is on human relations and interdependence
- Empathy is mainly emotional, empathic woman feels others
- Of course, she also thinks and make rational plans

# Men's perspective

- Man understands mainly cognitively
- Individualistic concepts of the human being – is free and self-determined
- People aim at material profit and consider potential risk
- Informed consent is agreement done between two self-determined persons



- Environmental health is a matter of experts, provided for self-determined persons
- One day experts will fully understand our world and they will help humans to organize everything in such a way that everybody will be happy



### Two weak points

- Men are free but isolated and alone
- The world is extremely complex. And we never will be able to understand the world sufficiently to make everybody happy

# In fact human being is not isolated

- Human being exists in relations with other people
- 1923 Martin Buber: I and You
- 1927 Martin Heidegger: Sein und Zeit (Being and time)
- Emanuel Levinas: Totalité et infini, (Totality and infinity)



### **Group analysis**

- The patient is group
- Group can be functional and dysfunctional
- Group unconsciousness
- In human mind we can see besides I (ego) also instance "we"



#### **Economy**

- 1988 Amitai Etzioni: The Moral Dimension: Toward a New Economics
- 2012 Tomáš Sedláček: Economics of the good and evil
- Invisible hand of market must be balanced by invisible hand of morality



#### Men's care

- Care means to take in account as much perspectives as it is possible
- That is possible only in group setting
- Dialogue and deliberation
- Perspective taking of people concerned

# Men's version" of care ethics

- Based on negotiation, dialogue and deliberation
- Care shows respect for perspectives of all stakeholders
